

Mounting Instructions for Acrylic Artwork from Wild Apple Open Studio™

Directions for mounting onto drywall:



Tools needed:

Phillips screwdriver
level
pencil




Mounting hardware included:

1 paper template
4 wall anchors
4 screws
4 stand-off mounts (cap & base)



1.

Using the level, position template against wall exactly where you want art to hang. With pencil, mark wall using the 4 holes in the template. Remove template.



2.

Center point of a wall anchor on one pencil mark. Push anchor in, then screw and push until anchor is FLUSH with wall. Repeat with remaining anchors.



3.

Unscrew caps from bases of the 4 stand-offs. Use the screws to attach the 4 stand-off bases into the wall anchors.



4.

Continue for all 4 stand-offs. Be careful not to over-tighten.



5.

Place the artwork over the stand-off bases, and attach the artwork with the stand-off caps. This should be done by two people, especially for larger size artwork.

Care and Cleaning of Acrylic Art from Wild Apple Open Studio

You are now the proud owner of a fine piece of art printed on acrylic. We at Wild Apple Open Studio would like to offer these suggestions to help you get the most value from your purchase.

To clean your artwork without scratching it, first blow off dust or dirt, or use water and a soft cloth to float off the dirt. Use a mild solution of dish detergent and warm water to take off stubborn dirt easily without harming the acrylic. Never use cleaners containing ammonia. Cleaners such as Windex or 409 will harm your new piece of art printed on acrylic.

Never use a dry cloth or your hand to clean your acrylic! This rubs the dirt and dust INTO the acrylic as much as it rubs it OFF.

Handle your acrylic art with care.

Dropping acrylic can cause cracking. We suggest help from a friend for safer handling.
